This notification is provided to fulfill the requirement of section 763.93(4) of the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act, 40 CFR Part 763, October 30, 1987 (AHERA).

The Kearsarge Regional School District's AHERA Management Plan is available for public inspection upon request at the SAU office, 114 Cougar Court New London, NH 03257. All interested parents, teachers, employees, or other persons are invited to review the plan which includes the following items:

- 1. Results of surveys and assessments of asbestos containing materials (ACM) performed by certified inspection personnel.
- 2. A detailed plan for managing ACM in the facility
- 3. A program for operations and maintenance activities to avoid accidental disturbance of ACM during routine maintenance and for abatement services as required.
- 4. A program for periodic surveillance of ACM and an emergency response action plan to address unanticipated problems.

It is important to note that the Environmental Protection Agency has indicated that the presence of asbestos containing materials in buildings does not in itself constitute a health hazard. If the material is not damaged or disturbed, it is not a danger to workers or other occupants. The KRSD Asbestos Management Plan is designed to ensure that any asbestos containing materials remain in good condition until removed during a major renovation or modernization project.
