Kearsarge Regional School District Shares Information About Minor School Bus Crash

NEW LONDON – The Kearsarge Regional School District wishes to share the following information about a minor collision involving a District school bus and a plow truck on Thursday morning.

Bus 41 was traveling eastbound on Otterville Road at about 7:30 a.m. to pick up New London Elementary School students who live in the Town of Springfield. A plow truck entered the intersection of Otterville Road and Goose Hill Road, colliding with the school bus.

No students were on board at the time of the crash.

Both drivers were unharmed. The school bus and plow truck suffered light damage.

Student Services Director Larry Elliott responded to the scene to assist the driver. Elliot also relayed information to SAU 65 administration and Student Transportation of America, the District's transportation provider.

Due to current conditions with routes and staffing, Bus 41 students could not be transported to school. The District has contacted all Bus 41 parents via voicemail, and is working to ensure that students waiting at bus stops have been picked up.
