IV	KRHS Lighting Project Approval – Scott Lanier, District Electrician, presented a purchase recommendation for \$279,450.78 to upgrade lighting at the high school. This expenditure will pay for itself over 52 months, and allow for a rebate from Eversource, and have long term savings to the district. <i>Dr. Bobruff made the motion to approve the expenditure of \$279,450.78 for the high school lighting upgrade, Ms. Bates seconded.
