V. New Business	<p><i>A. <u>Kearsarge regional High School Principal Nomination:</u></i> The Superintendent was pleased to announce the nomination of Charles Langille, as KRHS Principal. He reviewed the interview process with members stating there was a very broad representation of teachers, students and parents during the initial round. There was three finalists in a secondary round. The Superintendent felt this selection was the best choice for nomination.
