

## Principal's Message:

Today marks the 101st day of school. Students celebrated the 100th day yesterday with lots of different math activities and discussion about how life looked 100 years ago. Yesterday also began the staff's book read of "Building Thinking Classrooms in Mathematics." We are learning about different strategies to engage students in critical thinking during math instruction. If you are interested in learning more, you can listen to a short podcast from the author here.

We have a few big events coming up next week. First, **Valentine's** Day is next Wednesday. As a general rule, if your child's classroom is celebrating Valentine's Day, please make sure that your child includes all students. If your Valentine cards include candy/food (store bought only), teachers will send these home at the end of the day. There is also a PD day next Tuesday, February 13th. There is no school for students on that day. Staff will be collaborating with other district grade-level teams to revisit grade-level competencies and learning targets. This is really the first chance this year for all district teams to discuss how curriculum changes are working at each grade level and content areas. Next Friday is the **PTO Lip Sync**. Students have been working hard with Mrs. Downs and Mrs. Allen to prepare their acts for this event. Please consider attending to support Simonds students and the PTO. If you do attend, it is important to remember that this is not a school event. Teachers and staff are there to support their students and not to manage behavior. Please remind your children to be a respectful audience while they are in attendance.

Simonds is also working on two, special projects this month. First, all classrooms are working on **Simonds Loves Synonyms** this month. We are working to identify synonyms of various words throughout the month. This is part of an initiative to increase student vocabulary. Last month, we worked on homonyms. Many of us are taking a reading course called LETRS (Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling). In this course we are learning about the importance of a strong vocabulary in reading comprehension. Lastly, Simonds is celebrating **Random Acts of Kindness** Month. Next week, students and staff will be recognizing acts of kindness that they see throughout the school.

We are beginning the process of **kindergarten registration**. If you have a child who will be starting kindergarten next year, please reach out to Mrs. Grimes in the main office. Or, if you know of another family that may not receive this newsletter, please let them know to call us. For now, it is important for us to get a general count of our kindergarten numbers so that we can plan classes. Later in the year, we will plan a chance for our incoming students to meet the teachers and other students.
